

**City of Woodway

The Parks and Recreation Commission of the City of Woodway held a regular meeting at Woodway City Hall (City Council Chambers) at 922 Estates Drive, Woodway, Texas 76712 on May 23, 2024, at 5:30 pm.

1. Call to order

Kevin Tankersley called the meeting to order at 5:31 pm.

2. Public Comment

There being no visitors who wished to speak, the Chair closed the floor at 5:32pm.

3. Discussion and consider action on the minutes of the special meeting held February 22, 2024

Nancy Goebel made a motion, seconded by Kristin Jack, to open discussion and consider action on the minutes. Emily Warren was listed as both present and absent. She was present for the February 22nd meeting. Mary Cunningham made a motion, seconded by Nancy Goebel, to approve the minutes with corrections. The motion carried unanimously.

4. Updates from City Council liaison

Council liaison Storey Cook provided information relating to ongoing and upcoming projects.

5. Disc golf course at Woodway Lakeside Park

- a. Presentation on potential upgrades
- b. Discussion and consider action on recommendations for plans to rehabilitate disc golf course

Kevin Tankersley announced that the presenter would be unable to attend the meeting and that this presentation would be postponed until the next regular meeting.

6. PAW walking track (at corner of Midway Drive and Estates Drive)

- a. Presentation from Woodway Elementary PTA on lighting updates to PAW walking track

Ashley Schupp and Lindsey Carl, representatives of the Woodway Elementary PTA, gave a brief presentation regarding the existing lighting, their plans for the future of the PAW and its potential uses, and their request for the City's partnership on upgrading the lighting. The current estimate for the lighting upgrade is \$63,690.

Note that after the presentation, the meeting was suspended for approximately 5-10 minutes due to a tornado warning.

- b. Discussion and consider action on recommendation regarding potential partnership between Midway ISD and the City of Woodway for the City to provide updates lighting around the PAW

Kristin Jack made a motion, seconded by Nancy Goebel, to open the discussion. The members asked about public and City use of the PAW area and briefly discussed the item. Emily Warren made a motion, seconded by Barbara Grandy, to recommend approval of a partnership between Midway ISD and the City of Woodway to upgrade the lighting at the PAW, to include an expenditure of \$63,690.

7. Update on Woodway Family Center from WFC Superintendent

Jimmy provided a brief update on WFC programming since the opening of the new building.

8. Sub-committee reports


- a. Poage Park
City staff is working to clean up downed trees and branches after the recent storms.
- b. Whitehall Park
There were no concerns noted.
- c. Activity Park
This park remains closed as weather has delayed the repair of the road.
- d. Lakeside Park
This park remains closed due to safety concerns from flooding and debris.
- e. Woodway Family Center
The members deferred to superintendent's update.

9. Update on upcoming events

City Council liaison Cook and staff member Kasia Redden provided a calendar of upcoming meetings, events, and new Woodway Family Center programming.

10. Adjournment of meeting

Kris Tooley made a motion for adjournment, seconded by Kristin Jack. The motion carried unanimously, and Chairperson Kevin Tankersley adjourned the meeting at 6:58 pm.
