1. Call to order

Kevin Tankersley called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM.

2. Public Comment

Public comments were moved to follow Agenda Item 4 to allow the WFC presentation to address potential questions and concerns beforehand.

The following residents spoke regarding concerns for the preservation of the former Family Center rather than its demolition. Speakers stated that the post-tension slab would not pose an issue and suggested repurposing the building as a senior center or as additional space for the new Woodway Family Center. Concerns were raised regarding the uphill incline at the new Family Center's location, with comments indicating that retaining the former building could improve accessibility for seniors. Some commenters referenced the potential benefits of a senior center for mental and physical well-being and noted that seniors make up 46% of the community's population. Comments also included concerns about the availability of recreational spaces for seniors compared to those for youth.

Commissioner Whitby raised concerns regarding the need for resurfacing the tennis court. This issue will be discussed further at the next meeting as part of the park-related budget items.

d. Lakeside Park

Commissioner Jack inquired about kayak kiosks. This topic will be discussed further at the next meeting as part of the park-related budget items.

e. Woodway Family Center

The park appears to be in good condition.



7. Update from City Staff on upcoming events.

City Council Liaison John Williams thanked the board for their service and announced his departure as liaison to the commission.

8. Adjournment of meeting.
