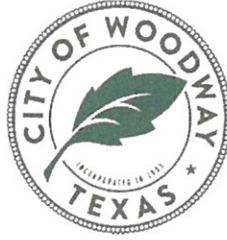


Public Notice of Meeting

Discussion and consider action on Ordinance 26-06, approving a negotiated settlement between the ATMOS Cities Steering Committee ("ACSC") and Atmos Energy Corp., Mid-Tex Division regarding the Company's 2026 rate review mechanism filing; declaring existing rates to be unreasonable; adopting tariffs that reflect rate adjustments consistent with the negotiated settlement; finding the rates to be set by attached settlement tariffs to be just and reasonable and in the public interest; approving an attachment establishing a benchmark for pensions and retiree medical benefits and requiring the company to reimburse ACSC's reasonable ratemaking expenses

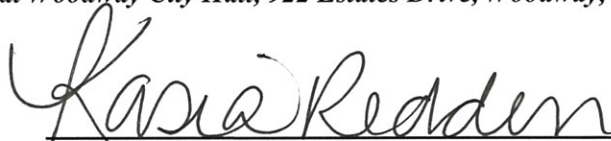
