

Memorial Day Closure & Trash Schedule

City offices will be closed on Monday, May 29th in observance of Memorial Day. Please also be aware that all scheduled trash pickups that week will be delayed one day due to the holiday.

Water Restrictions Continue

- No watering between the hours of 10 a.m. & 8 p.m. daily.
- Odd number addresses may water Monday/Wednesday/Saturday.
- Even number addresses may water Sunday/Tuesday/Thursday.
- No watering on Fridays.
- Hand watering allowed on all days of the week.
- No washing of any motor vehicle, motorbike, boat, trailer, airplane nor any other vehicle between 10 a.m. & 8 p.m. on the designated watering days. Vehicle washing may be done at any time on the immediate premises of a commercial car wash or commercial service station.
- No watering to fill, refill, or add to any indoor or outdoor swimming pools, wading pools, or Jacuzzi-type pools between 10 a.m. and 8 p.m. on the designated watering days.

Keep Woodway Beautiful

The City's affiliation with Keep Texas Beautiful provides access to educational materials, cleanup event supplies, and grant opportunities, including the Governor's Community Achievement Award and \$160,000 grant won just last year. Eligibility for these amazing opportunities and resources require every affiliate to attain a status of Good Standing, Silver Star, or Gold Star each year. Each level has graduated requirements for reporting, education, and participation in KTB-sponsored events, and is determined by KTB staff after review of a final comprehensive annual report.

The review of our 2022 KTB Annual Report is now complete. We were able to secure Good Standing with our participation in Household Hazardous Waste Day, a Fall Sweep cleanup supply handout, and a spring cleanup by the Woodway Youth Commission. The City's Plan Reviewer, Kasia Redden, acts as Keep Texas Beautiful affiliate coordinator and prepares the related supply requests, grant applications, and reports for submission. This year, she attended an additional 16 hours of virtual and in-person training to boost the hard work of our amazing staff and citizens, and we are proud to announce that the City of Woodway has earned Silver Star Affiliate status through Keep Texas Beautiful for the second year in a row!







Reminders from Code Enforcement & Animal Control



Sec 11-1: High Grass, Weeds, and Brush

The City is asking for compliance and help to keep grass, weeds, and brush mowed and trimmed according to the City Ordinance (Sec 11-1 high grass). All grass, weeds, and brush should be kept to a height no taller than twelve (12) inches in any location. Keeping grass cut to proper length also helps lessen the possibility of grass fires and aids in controlling mosquitos, fleas, ticks, and other pests. Due to the recent rain, the grass is growing fast; so, you may need to mow your yard more often. Violations could result in a fine not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) and not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense.

Sec. 3-20: Dog Running at Large

At large: Shall mean an animal that is not restrained by some physical means to the premises of the owner. Provided, however, that an animal shall not be considered "at large" when held and controlled by some person by means of a leash or restraint of proper strength and length to control the actions of the animal, or while confined within a vehicle or cage. An animal shall be deemed at large when not under restraint. Violations could result in a fine not less than ten dollars (\$10.00)offense. five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and not more than for each

Understanding Tornado Alerts

What is the difference between a Tornado Watch and a Tornado Warning issued by the National Weather Service?

Tornado Watch: Be Prepared! Tornadoes are possible in and near the watch area. Review and discuss your emergency plans and check supplies and your safe room. Be ready to act quickly if a warning is issued or you suspect a tornado is approaching. Acting early helps to save lives! Watches are issued by the Storm Prediction Center for counties where tornadoes may occur. The watch area is typically large, covering numerous counties or even states.

Tornado Warning: Take Action! A tornado has been sighted or indicated by weather radar. There is imminent danger to life and property. Move to an interior room on the lowest floor of a sturdy building. Avoid windows. If in a mobile home, a vehicle, or outdoors, move to the closest substantial shelter and protect yourself from flying debris. Warnings are issued by your local forecast office. Warnings typically encompass a much smaller area (around the size of a city or small county) that may be impacted by a tornado identified by a forecaster on radar or by a trained spotter/law enforcement who is watching the storm.
