Large Item Pickup is now in April!

The City offers two complimentary Large Item Pickup services a year for citizens. These dates are scheduled in collaboration with Frontier Waste Solutions and will fall on whichever is your second trash day of the week. The first Large Item Pickup service for 2024 is scheduled for April 25th and 26th. When utilizing this pickup service, please limit the number of items placed curbside. Televisions & tires must be brought to the landfill to dispose of, and refrigerators must be tagged by a licensed professional to be picked up curbside. No hazardous waste is collected on these dates, but they can be disposed on the City's Household Hazardous Waste Day on March 23rd.

To schedule an additional Large Item Pickup service for your address, contact Customer Service at City Hall at 254.772.4480 or email customerservice@woodwaytexas.gov. The cost for the additional service is \$75.

Sewer Rate Changes

Each year, sewer rates are calculated on the average water consumption billed on each household's February and March water billings. The new sewer rate then goes into effect starting with the April bill. The City uses the consumption average from winter months since most households are not using excess water for landscaping and pools during that time. Instead, most consumption is only for daily activities, such as showering and washing clothes and dishes. This gives the most accurate idea of gray water used in each household. Water leaks do affect the sewer average, so if a leak is suspected, please let the Utility Billing Department know by emailing customerservice@woodwaytexas.gov or calling 254.772.4480. Save-the-Date for Household Hazardous Waste Day 2024



The City of Waco Solid Waste Department is hosting its annual Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day, which provides residents with a FREE service for the disposal of potentially hazardous items. This event is for all Waco, Bellmead, Hewitt, Lacy Lakeview, and Woodway residents living within their city limits. Residents who do not register ahead of time must bring a city utility bill or other proof of city residency and a driver's license. Please BE PREPARED TO WAIT IN LINE!

Acceptable Items

- Paints
- CFL & Florescent bulbs
- · Batteries of all kinds
- Electronics
- Scrap tires (5 per household, off the rim, max size 20 inches)
- · Automotive fluids and filters
- Insecticides
- Weed Killers
- Pool Chemicals
- Cleaners
- Poisons
- Corrosives
- Flammables

Unacceptable Items

- · Containers larger than 5 gallons
- · Agricultural Chemicals
- Dioxins
- Explosives/fireworks/ammunition
- Industrial or commercial business waste
- Radioactive material
- Large Appliances
- · Trash or garbage
